Neuropsychological and Psychoeducational Assessments

Drexel University students seeking formal neuropsychological/psychoeducational assessment of attention deficit/hyperactivity (ADHD), learning disability (e.g., dyslexia/reading disorder, mathematics disorder, disorder of written expression), language disorders or other related problems should consult with the Office of Disability Services (ODS), which is located at 3201 Arch Street, Suite 210, and can be reached by telephone at 215-895-1401. The ODS can provide a list of neuropsychologists and other professionals who can administer the necessary assessment interviews and testing battery.

The Drexel University Student Counseling Center on the Center City Campus (located on the 3rd floor of the Bellet Building) is able to administer neuropsychological and psychoeducational assessments to Drexel students from all campuses. **The cost of these assessments is \$400.** (Once it is determined that the Counseling Center will perform testing, students will be given a Bursar Payment Receipt that they must bring to the Bursar along with payment. The Bursar's office will stamp the receipt which the student is to return to the Counseling Center as documentation of payment.) In determining whether to choose the Student Counseling Center or another entity to perform testing, students should consider the information below.

Testing will be carried out by Counseling Center staff who are trainees in the Clinical Psychology doctoral program at Drexel. All assessments will be overseen by a licensed neuropsychologist or psychologist associated with the Counseling Center. The process involves several steps including (1) an interview (for which there is no fee) to determine the referral problem, to gather facts relevant to the problem, to determine whether testing is necessary and, if so, which specific tests are indicated; (2) test administration, which can span several sessions and generally takes six to eight hours to complete; (3) test scoring and analysis; (4) report writeup; (5) feedback to student; and (6) distribution of testing report to ODS and/or to others as requested by the student. The entire process generally takes two to four weeks, although several factors (e.g., student availability, test battery length, data complexity) may extend this timeframe. Counseling Center staff will serve as diagnosticians by administering, scoring and interpreting the results of testing, but are not authorized to approve any type of accommodation; only the ODS determines eligibility for accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities Act and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act.
