Professional Doctor of Physical Therapy APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Application** – applications are mailed on request or students can apply online (<http://www.drexel.edu/em/apply/cnhp/> The application fee is waived if you apply online.)
- Official transcripts** from all universities attended as well as satisfactory completion (grade of 'C' or higher) or plan to complete the following prerequisites:
 - General Biology with laboratory: 2 courses
 - Mammalian or Human Physiology (preferably with lab): 1 course (OR the 2-part series of Anatomy and Physiology I, II)
 - Advanced Biology: 1 course (An upper-divisional course at the 300-400 level. IE: Cell Biology, Pharmacology, Comparative Anatomy, Histology, Genetics, Research in Biology, Exercise Physiology)
 - General Chemistry with laboratory: 2 courses
 - General Physics with laboratory: 2 courses
 - Psychology
 - General Psychology: 1 course
 - Second Psychology: 1 course (Abnormal or Developmental preferred)
 - Introductory Statistics: 1 course
 - Humanities and Social Sciences: 5 courses (any non-science class qualifies)
- Official GRE scores** (Drexel's code is 2194)
- PT Supplemental Application** (www.drexel.edu/em/apply/cnhp/ghs-PT-CIF.pdf)
- Essay** (1 page, www.drexel.edu/em/apply/cnhp/p_dpt_pt.html)
- Resume**
- Documented work or volunteer experience** (no specific number of hours or form are required. Work/volunteer experience may be reflected in resume, PT letter of reference, and/or essay)
- Two letters of recommendation** (no form is required; a letter of recommendation is sufficient; may be addressed to the Admissions Committee or 'To Whom It May Concern')
 - One letter is required from an academic source
 - One letter is required from a physical therapist
- International students must also submit:
 - **TOEFL** (applicants who have not received a degree in the US are required to take the TOEFL. An official score report must be sent directly from the Educational Testing Service (ETS). Drexel's TOEFL code is 2194.)
 - **I-20/DS-2019**
 - **Transcript evaluation** by World Education Services, Inc. (www.wes.org) or International Consultants of Delaware, Inc. (www.icdel.com)
