Thank you for participating in the Mid-Atlantic Chapter of the Construction Management Association of America's Student Leadership Award Competition!

Please be guided by the following application rules in developing your essay:

1. Topic:

Create a Request for Proposal (RFP) for Construction Management Services for a project (defined by the student). The RFP should define the roles and responsibilities of the Construction Manager in a "future" time indicating how current practices would improve and the value of using Certified Construction Managers (CCM). Include references for your topic.

2. **Length:** 1500 to 2500 words, not including references and brief bio.
3. **Format:** The first sheet will be this completed application. Next, prepare a cover sheet for your essay followed by your essay and references, prepared in MSWord (*.doc or *.pdf) format, double spaced, 11 pt. Arial font. Provide a brief biography of the student in less than 100 words.
4. **Deadline for submission: MARCH 30, 2009**
5. **Presentation of Awards:** Award recipients will receive recognition of their awards at the CMAA Chapter Annual Awards meeting on May 4, 2009 at the DuPont Country Club, Wilmington, DE.
6. **Awards and Eligibility:** Grants are intended to be awarded to full time and/or part-time college students pursuing an undergraduate curriculum related to the construction industry, who reside or attend college in PA, NJ, DE and MD. Proof of enrollment via transcript or most recent grades must accompany submission. The number and amount of grants depend on the amount of funds available. The Chapter intends to award three grants between \$2000 and \$500. Those submissions not qualifying for a monetary award, when submitted in acceptable form and reasonable substance, will be given an "honor award" in the form of a certificate of appreciation at the banquet.
7. **Method of submission of essay:** Submit your Student Leadership Award essay and proof of enrollment **via email**. Submissions must be received by the close of business on **MARCH 30, 2009**. Address submission to:
