Basic Policies

- Memberships are non-refundable and member must maintain active status in membership eligibility guidelines to maintain Recreation Center membership.
- Locker sales are non-refundable. Once an annual locker has expired without renewal, the lock will be removed and items will be discarded after 48 hours.
- Guests must sign-in with their sponsor member, have a photo-ID, and must be accompanied by their sponsor member at all times in the facility. Members may sponsor up to two guests per day. Guest fee is \$15 per guest. Guests must be at least 15 years old and all sponsors must be at least 18 years old.
