

Announcement – Creation of whistleblower hotlines

Drexel University is committed to conducting its affairs in full compliance with the law and its own policies and procedures. Such adherence strengthens and promotes ethical and fair practices and treatment of all members of the University and those who conduct business with it.

While we have developed and implemented internal controls and procedures that we hope will deter and prevent improper conduct, there should be a way for members of the University community to bring instances of improper conduct to the attention of someone who can be counted upon to investigate the problem promptly and fairly, without any fear of retaliation.

Drexel University College of Medicine established a compliance “hotline” in April 2000, and Drexel University will now have one as well. Effective immediately, the following telephone numbers may be used to report any improper conduct:

Every call to these telephone numbers will be kept completely confidential. No information likely to reveal your identify will be shared with anyone else without your permission. Callers will be completely protected from retaliation for having made good faith reports.
