Important Information on the PHYS 050 Online Summer Course

■ **WHAT is PHYS 050?**

Students are invited to participate in the PHYS 050 based upon the unique outcome of their calculus placement exam. PHYS 050 is a self-paced 6-week online course beginning August 1, 2011. This zero (0) credit course is completely free of charge. PHYS 050 is designed to refresh incoming freshman students of the physics-related math concepts that were learned in high school. Successful completion of the course will place the student into PHYS 101 for the fall quarter. This voluntary course is available to all incoming students. The deadline to complete this course is September 11, 2011.

■ **HOW do I take PHYS 050?**

■ **WHAT happens if I do not take PHYS 050?**

Students who do not successfully complete PHYS 050 will be required to take and pass an in-class course before taking PHYS 101. PHYS 050 is a preparatory course that must be completed prior to enrollment in PHYS 101, the first calculus-based course required for your degree.
