

# PLACEMENT EXAMINATIONS



## *Important Information for Incoming Freshman*

### WHAT are Placement Exams?

Placement exams have been developed by Drexel faculty to ensure students are appropriately placed into courses. These examinations reflect the proficiency that is expected of students to be ready for the curriculum presented in the various college level Mathematics, English, Chemistry and Modern Language courses.

### ■ HOW do I take my Placement Exam(s)?

Most placement exams are administered online. Please review the Guide to Taking The Placement Examination(s) at <http://www.drexel.edu/provost/placement>. This guide will help you learn how to pick up your accounts (if you haven't already done so), configure your computer, and take your required exams. If you are requesting accommodations on the placement examination(s) due to a disability, you must register with the Office of Disability Services (ODS) prior to receiving the testing accommodations. Students should plan to register as soon as possible, as the process may take some time. ### ■ HOW do I find out what exams I need to take?

When you are ready to take your examination(s), access <http://one.drexel.edu>

Note: it is important that you take these examinations very seriously.

To access your placement examinations, login to DrexelOne and navigate the following:

1. Click on the “**Students**” tab
2. In the center column, you will see a channel called “**Course Services**” – Click the “**My Courses**” link
3. On this page, find the “**Courses I’m Attending**” heading and find your required examinations list. If your exams are not listed, find the “**Incoming Freshmen**” heading below and click “**Bb-Vista**”
4. Log in one last time with your username and password
5. Find the center channel “**Course List**” – your examinations are listed in this area
