## *Important Information on the English Placement Exam*

### ■ **WHAT is the English Placement Exam?**

The English placement exam is used by the University to help place incoming freshman into an English course that best suits their ability and needs. The English placement examination is comprised of a short essay based on a single prompt, which will require you to take and support a position on an issue. You are asked to write in an appropriate tone and with a minimum of grammatical and mechanical mistakes.

### ■ **WHO needs to take the English Placement Exam?**

If you did not take either the SAT, ACT and/or TOEFL exam, you must take the English Examination. If you have completed the SAT(including the SAT Essay), ACT and/or TOEFL exam, your placement will be based on these scores.
