## *Manage Your Mastery of Mathematics*

### ■ **WHAT is ALEKS?**

ALEKS prepares and supports student mathematical mastery while studying at Drexel. Students can initially evaluate their mathematical knowledge and use the tool for continuous growth and mastery of the subject.

### ■ **WHY use it?**

ALEKS is a unique system that avoids multiple choice questions and asks students – depending on their familiarity with mathematics – varying questions that assist in evaluating his or her mastery of the subject. The system develops a 'snapshot' of the student's knowledge of the subject, identifying valuable outputs such as core strengths and opportunities for improvement. Students are encouraged to use this tool to evaluate their core competency in mathematics on a quarterly basis.
