■ WHAT is DegreeWorks?

The University has implemented DegreeWorks, a web-based academic advising system for degree audit and course planning. DegreeWorks is a powerful tool to assist students in reaching their academic goals and better understand degree requirements. All undergraduate students entering the university in September 2007 or later have access to DegreeWorks.

■ WHY use DegreeWorks?

Through DegreeWorks, students have the capability to plan for upcoming terms during the academic year by mapping out courses needed for graduation, displaying course pre-requisites, calculating grades needed to achieve a desired cumulative GPA, and utilizing a "What if" feature that allows students to create numerous hypothetical scenarios regarding their academic future such as a change in major. Students are encouraged to use this valuable self-advisement tool regularly to track their progress towards completing curriculum requirements as well as plan future registrations.

■ HOW do I access DegreeWorks?

DegreeWorks can be accessed through the DrexelOne Portal at <http://one.drexel.edu>. Upon login, select the Students tab and click **More BannerWeb Student Records**. In the Student Records box, select **DegreeWorks Audit**.
