Psychology seeks the answers to a broad variety of questions regarding the behavior, thoughts, and emotions of individuals. These questions range from the biochemical basis of memory and the effects of stress on health to understanding the causes of emotional problems or such experiences as falling in love. These questions are studied by using scientific research techniques both in the laboratory and the “real” world. The answers are applied in fields such as business, the health sciences, pharmaceuticals, law, education, counseling and the design of useful and usable technologies.

Psychology majors are well trained in research data analysis and find employment opportunities in research and corporate settings more readily. Many students also go on to graduate programs and pursue professions such as clinical psychology, school psychology, experimental psychology, or law school.
