


### Pre - college fair

- Remember your nametag


### **During the fair**


### **CSS Profile**


The CSS Profile is now required for students interested in receiving institutional need-based aid. These are funds that Drexel has made available for students who have a demonstrated financial need. The CSS Profile must be received by November 15th (Early Action/Early Decision) or February 15th (Regular Decision).

# FAFSA Free Application for Federal Student Aid

For students interested in receiving federal, state, and institutional need-based aid, must submit a FAFSA form by the February 15<sup>th</sup> deadline.


