

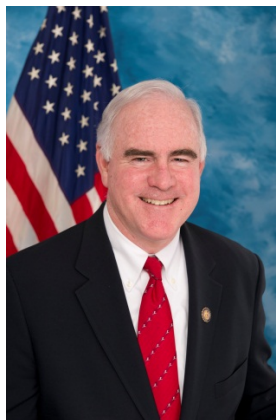


ASERT Autism Resource Fair
