### **Criteria for being self-employed while on co-op:**

- The co-op must be a student's second or final co-op.
- Interview and provide supporting documentation to determine that the business has:
  - a. Tested and validated business model
  - b. Money and resources already invested or have a customer base
  - c. Product or service
  - d. Statement of goals for the business during the co-op period
- The business cannot be a franchisee or a networking marketing business (pyramid scheme).
- The student has a minimum GPA of 2.5 and has successfully completed ENTP 499: Launch It!

### **Documents showing proof of these criteria must be submitted along with this application form.**

The application should include a letter of recommendation from a former employer and an updated resume. The submission deadline will be the start of B round for upcoming cycle (approximately two months prior to the start of co-op).

In addition, all students who are self-employed while on co-op must have completed ENTP 499: Launch It! or enroll for the course within the academic year.
