The College of Arts and Sciences regards training in pedagogy and instruction to be core to the mission of doctoral education. Therefore, all JD/PhD in Law and Psychology students are required to perform significant teaching duties (defined over multiple terms) during their pursuit of their degree. These activities may include, but are not limited to:

- Supervising teaching labs
- Running course recitations
- Teaching as the primary instructor
- Running student seminars
- Training junior researchers in core research methods
- Running or actively participating in pedagogical seminars or conferences

Alternate fulfillment of this requirement is at the discretion of the program director and the head of the student's home department.
