

University Housing Fast Facts

THE COURTS

New for 2012! Drexel University has partnered with The Courts, a residential community at 3500 Powelton Avenue, to offer apartment-style housing options for its residential students!

What type of apartment layouts are available? There are 1 and 2-bedroom apartment types which house between 1 and 4 students.

Are the apartments furnished?

Yes. All students will receive an individual twin bed (size is 36x80), desk, and desk chair. Each common area will include couches and kitchen tables/chairs. Students will not be permitted to remove furniture provided by the University.

Will Drexel University students have non-University roommates?

No. Drexel University has leased the "B" building for exclusive use by Drexel University residential students. All assignments will be made by, and supervised by, University Housing. There may be non-Drexel University residents in the "A" and "C" buildings.

Will there be Drexel University staff at The Courts?

Yes. The Residential Living Office will supervise three undergraduate Resident Assistants who will live on-site at The Courts. In addition, an Assistant Director/Resident Director will be assigned to The Courts and hold regular on-site office hours.

The Courts is \$3,190 per quarter, per student.

Is there security at The Courts?

Yes. The Courts will operate a 24/7 front desk operation with a uniformed security officer. The Courts is also located within the Drexel University Police Department and Drexel Public Safety patrol areas.

Will Drexel University residents have access to the amenities offered by The Courts?

Yes. Drexel University residents can take full advantage of all amenities, including the fitness center and communal courtyard with grilling area.

Since cable television is not included in the cost of the room rate, how can residents obtain cable television services?


Cable television is indeed not included. Residents can contact local service providers such as Comcast to initiate service. The costs associated with cable television are the sole responsibility of individual apartments. Residents should discuss this with their roommates prior to requesting service.

Are there any other costs, such as utilities?

No. All utility costs, including hot water, heat, electricity, and refuse collection are included.


