### **Application Process**

Applying to the Program is a 3-step process

- 1. Submit the following application materials:

- 2. If selected, complete **in-person interview** between Monday, October 1 and Friday, October 5.
  - ☐ Bring completed Roommate Commitment form to interview (attached to this application).
  - ☐ You will hear from us shortly after if you have been selected to join the program.
- 3. If selected, attend the **New Ambassador Training** on Monday, October 8.
  - □ Note: please let us know of any issues or conflicts you have with the above items as soon as possible (email to execamb@drexel.edu).

# **Expectations of the Student Ambassador Program**

- Become a tour-trained guide by the end of Fall Term.
- Mingle with families during the Daily Visit Program, at least twice per term.
- If living in university housing, you must show your residence hall room during the event weekends. If you do not live in a Freshman residence hall, you will be assigned other roles.
- Attend Monthly Professional Development Meetings (exceptions can be made for class times).
- Complete tour requirements each subsequent term, which includes at least 3 campus tours and working 4 half-days on event weekends.

- 1. Why did you choose to attend Drexel? Why do you continue to choose Drexel?
- 2. Why are you interested in becoming a Student Ambassador? What qualities do you possess that will make you successful in the position?

Before applying please consider the requirements of the Student Ambassador Program. If you are chosen to become an ambassador, you are required to complete a series of 10 training steps to ensure that you are a well rounded tour guide for the University. Each training step, outlined below, must be completed by its deadline. Failure to complete training by the training deadline will result in removal from the program.

Presentation Shadow the presentation that prospective students attend before going on their tour.

Shadow 1 Shadow a tour led by a veteran ambassador.

Shadow 2 Shadow a tour led by a veteran ambassador.

Tour Quiz Pass a quiz, testing your knowledge of the university and its programs.

Mock Tour Give a mock tour to an executive ambassador.

Tag 1 Tag team a tour with an executive ambassador. You are responsible for 25% of the stops.

Tag 2 Tag team another tour with an exec. This time you are responsible for 75% of the stops.

Exec Shadow Give a solo tour to a group of prospective families while an exec shadows your tour.

Mingling 1&2<sup>1</sup> Mingle with families in the Visit Center before their presentation.

Security Clearances<sup>1</sup> Complete all the required clearances to complete your training.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Can be completed at any point in the training process after the training day, but must be completed before exec shadow.

### **Room Guide Commitment Form**
