5. You can also add a video from Drexel Streams to the text editor that exists for you when you add various objects to Blackboard Learn (e.g. an Item). From the Edit screen, scroll to the text editor and make sure the editor's menu is expanded fully by clicking the **More** (...) button if it is not already. Click the **Add content** button.

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6. The Add content window will appear. Scroll down to Additional Tools and select **Kaltura Media Item**.
