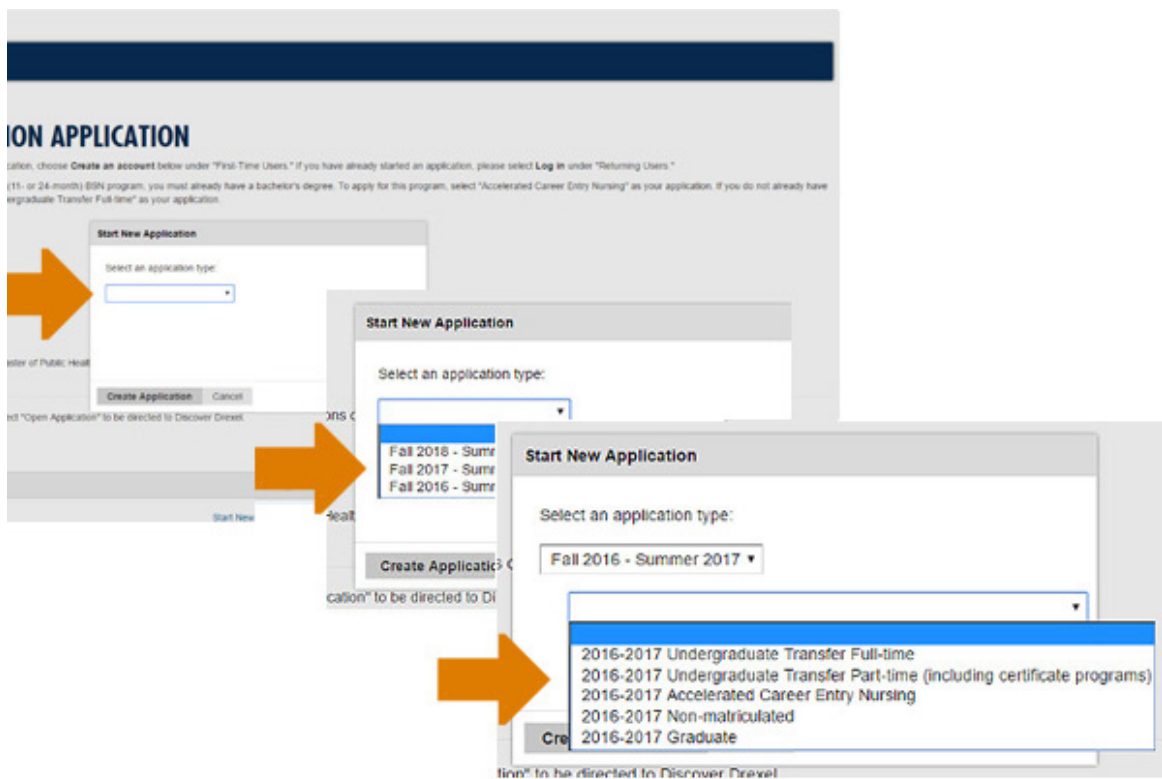
Step 5:

Step 6:

Step 7:
