**Teaching Professor Positions**

The *Department of Mechanical Engineering and Mechanics* (MEM) at Drexel University, Philadelphia, PA, invites applications to fill up to five Teaching Professor positions to start in the summer (July 01, 2014) or Fall (September 01, 2014) quarter. Of particular interest are candidates who will support our teaching mission in the department with classes held at the main campus and two regional campuses at Burlington County CC and Montgomery County CC. Minimum qualifications include a Ph.D. degree in Mechanical Engineering and some demonstrable experience in classroom teaching. Responsibilities of the successful candidates include teaching mainly the undergraduate courses in the areas of Mechanical Systems, Solid Mechanics, Thermo-fluid sciences, and Design and Manufacturing. Prior teaching experience is highly desirable. The positions are non-tenured 9-month academic appointments.

With more than 1000 undergraduate and 150 graduate students, the Department offers doctoral and Master's programs in Mechanical Engineering (ME) and a Bachelor's programs in ME (ABET-accredited). The instructional and research activities are conducted by over 30 tenured/tenure-track and teaching faculty members.

Drexel University is located in Philadelphia, PA with an excellent industrial base that includes energy, defense, aerospace, plastics, chemicals, biotechnology, and medical devices. The successful candidates will have an excellent opportunity to build collaborative partnerships with nearby universities, industry and government labs located within close proximity to the Drexel campus.
