Anthropology is the study of human beings — the various cultures, traditions, and daily practices that define, separate, and unite us. Through detailed study and field experience, anthropologists strive to gain a thorough understanding of the world's populations.

Students majoring in anthropology broaden their understanding of the diversity of cultures and ways of life in the global environment through theoretical courses, content area courses, and specialized courses in field techniques and methodology.
