A National Security Education Program Initiative Administered by the Institute of International Education

- National Security Education Act in 1991
- Provide funding for undergraduate students to study in areas critical to national security

Africa \* Asia \* Central & Eastern Europe \* Eurasia Latin America \* Middle East

- Emphasize learning less commonly taught languages
- Require 1 year of federal government service

## What are Boren Scholarships?

- Boren Scholarships for undergraduates
- Boren Fellowships for graduate students

#### Eligibility:

U.S. citizen

- Enrolled at a U.S. college/university
- Not graduating until after Boren funding ends

# Scholarships and Fellowships

- Students design their own programs
- Programs and future goals must be connected to U.S. national security
- Broad definition of national security
- Award amount varies
- Deadlines: Jan and Feb

## Service Requirement

Department of Defense

Department of State

Intelligence Community

Department of Homeland Security

If a Scholar does not find a suitable position in one of the priority areas they can pursue any position within the federal government that contributes to national security.



### Critical Language Scholarship Program

Administered by the Department of State

- Overseas intensive summer language institutes in 13 critical need foreign languages
- Fully-funded group-based intensive language instruction for seven to ten weeks
- Continued language learning expected
- Deadline: Nov 15, 2010

# What is the CLS Program?



 Funds a year of advanced language study in East and Southeast Asia

#### Eligibility

- U.S. citizens or Permanent Residents
- Graduate student
- Pursue an academic, professional or business career that involves the regular use of a modern Asian language

Deadline: December 30, 2011

## Blakemore Freeman Fellowships



Fulbright Critical Language Enhancement Award

- Three to six months of intensive language study in addition to Fulbright research or study grants
- Some of the eligible languages include Arabic,
  Mandarin, Korean, and Russian
- Open to recent B.S./B.A. graduates, master's and doctoral candidates, young professionals and artists
- Most grantees plan their own research or study programs

Deadline: Sept/Oct 2011
