 - (b) explaining why a summer in the Solicitor's Office "fits" who you are and what you think you might want to do after graduation
 - (c) identifying two to three (maximum) divisions within the Solicitor's Office where you would prefer to work (ranking your preference and explaining your choices)
- 3. A personal reference from one of your professors at the law school, providing insight into what you would bring to the internship.

All applications will be considered by a selection committee.
