

# **CITI: RCR Instructions**

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The <u>National Science Foundation's (NSF) Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR) training</u> requirement has **expanded to include all faculty and senior personnel supported by NSF** funding for proposals submitted or due **on or after July 31, 2023**. RCR training is intended to help inform the university research community of the wide range of ethical and professional issues that must be considered to ensure a climate of research integrity. Drexel University requires all researchers to engage in ethical research practices based on regulatory standards and professional guidelines of the respected field.

This instruction aims to provide a step-by-step process on how to access the CITI training module for Responsible Conduct of Research as a first-time CITI user, a returning CITI user at Drexel, as well as how to associate CITI training completed under a previous Institution with Drexel University. CITI RCR training completed at a different Institution within the past 4 years will be accepted as documented RCR training if the individual's CITI account is linked with Drexel University.

# Account Set-up and First Time Core Training

Follow these instructions if you are new to the CITI program.

1. Visit the CITI website to get started.

2. Once on the home page, navigate to the upper right and click on "Register" box.

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3. After clicking "Register", choose "Select Your Organization Affiliation".



4. Type in Drexel University and select Drexel University from the drop-down list. Then agree to the Terms of Service and Privacy Policy as well as affirm to being an affiliate of Drexel University by checking the boxes below. Lastly, click the "Create a CITI Program account" box.
