Undergraduates:

- You have passed all required Candidacy criteria.
- You have completed all program course requirements
- You have confirmed with your Academic Advisor that you have meet all program requirements as outlined within your plan of study and are ready to participate in student teaching.
- You have no INCOMPLETE grades on your Drexel University academic transcript.
- Your overall GPA is at or above 3.0.
- You have no financial or academic "holds" on your Drexel University records.
- You have submitted your completed application online by the application deadline.
- All clearances must be current and submitted as directed to be considered for a placement. Additionally, many districts require the ACT24 clearance. Upon submitting your request for placement it is your responsibility to send all your current clearances directly to the Field Placement Office.
